### ORGANIZATION

We inform our employees about sustainability. After all, they are the ones who apply our policy in the workplace. We try to support them as much as possible. We do this, among other things, by providing them with work instructions that explain how they can apply this during work.

### VISITORS

We want to offer you an optimal stay and hope to inspire you to work with us on a better world. You too can contribute during your stay by making conscious choices. For example, we ask you to participate in our towels and linen reuse program. We also exchange towels and linen on request. In this way we create less laundry together and save many liters of water.

### SMART TECHNOLOGY

In addition to the solar panels on our roof, we have set up an extensive moss-sedum green roof. This contributes to better temperature control (insulation), collects rainwater and is good for the absorption of CO<sub>2</sub>. In addition, the heat stress in the summers of Amsterdam counteracts. To save energy, we have also fully equipped our hotel with LED lighting.
